

Hello Maple Mustangs,

We are excited to bring back our Mustang Read-A-Thon Fundraiser! This fundraiser is organized and facilitated by our Maple PFA, which means all funds raised will go directly back to Maple Elementary! Allocation of funds is as follows:

- 50% will go to Technology Upgrades in the Multi-Purpose Room (MPR) at Maple
- 50% will go toward Enrichment Activities (PE/Art/Music/STEAM Instruction) and Classroom Stipends/Field Trips.

We need our Maple Mustangs to help us reach our fundraising goal of \$8,000!

HOW IT WORKS

Maple students are encouraged to participate in reading activities during the course of our week-long Read-A-Thon, **Thursday, November 3rd - Thursday, November 10th**. Reading activities include:

- Reading during school
- As part of a homework assignment
- Independent reading

- With a family member/friend
- Listening to an audio book

Students will earn ONE point for every 10 minutes of reading activity, earning up to 24 reading points per day (max of 4 hours of reading activity).

Students can earn BONUS POINTS by engaging in additional activities, listed below (ONE point for each bonus activity):

- Read with a flashlight
- Read in a costume
- Build a fort and read in it
- Read outdoors
- Read to a stuffed animal or pet
- Read to a neighbor/friend/family member via video
- Share what you read with someone
- Read a recipe and help make it
- Draw an illustration that reflects what you read
- Rewrite the ending to a favorite book
- Write a story and read it to a friend/family member

All Reading and Bonus Points are tallied by student or parent/guardian at the end of the fundraiser, and **submitted no later than Monday, November 14th**, through the paper log included in the packet, or through the Google Form:

We would love 100% engagement from our Maple Mustangs and have a participation prize that is easy to earn! The PFA will be in front of the school at drop off/pick up November 3rd - November 10th to distribute participation prizes, or you can turn in the completed form to the front office at Maple Elementary so that your student will receive the participation prize.

Additional prizes can be earned by being the TOP POINT EARNER or TOP DONATION EARNER in your class, for your grade or for the entire school! The PFA will tally points and donations for students who turn in a paper record log or submit a record log through Google Forms by November 14th and will identify the Class/Grade/School winners during the week of November 14th - November 18th. Prizes will be distributed no later than November 18th. Please note that donations/pledges can not be split among students. Please reference the information included with this packet for prize level details.

If Maple Elementary is able to reach our goal of raising \$8000 to go towards Technology Improvements in the MPR, as well as Enrichment Programs/Classroom Stipend/Field Trip Funds, the ENTIRE SCHOOL will be treated to an Ice Cream Social to be held this Spring!!!

Dear Family Member/Friend,

The Parent Faculty Association (PFA) at my school is hosting a Read-A-Thon fundraiser to help raise money for technology upgrades in our school's Multi-Purpose Room, and enrichment activities such as PE, Music, Art and STEAM Instruction! Last year, the Read-a-Thon raised approximately \$3,500. We plan to exceed last year's total and aim for \$8,000. This is our big, main fundraiser for the year, so we need everyone's support.
